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Circuit Discovery Majunga:

Antananarivo – Ankarafantsika – Majunga – Anjohibe – Antananarivo (12 days /11 nights)



The highlights:

- Ecotourism; Ecolodge;
- Fine sand beach;
- Anjohibe Caves: the most important speleological site of Madagascar;
- Mahajamba Bay: waterfall, natural swimming pool;
- Visit to the Mangroves by canoe local.

D01: <u>ANTANANARIVO - ANKARAFANTSIK</u> (445km)

Road for Majunga, the National Highway RN4. Diverse landscape, passing through the Tampoketsa, wide undulating savannahs, typical villages, and ending at Ankarafantsika. Ankarafantsika is a magical park with deciduous dry forest.

DO2: ANKARAFANTSIKA - MAJUNGA (115km)

A 4-hour tour will give you a glimpse of the Park. A Coquereli circuit permits you to see the lemurs Sifaka, and an extension to the Baobab Circuit enable you to see the last existing endemic baobabs of type Andasonia madagascariensis, of the variety Boinensis. Continuation to Majunga.

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D03: MAJUNGA by QUAD

Jump on your quad and you'll accross beaches and fishing villages. Stop to Cirque Rouge; sedimentary formation of various colors. Continuation to Antsanitia. If the tide is good, you pass along the beach, about 12km. If the tide is not good, you leave by the tracks, about 15km. Lunch break in Antsanitia. Return back around 15h, passing by the Sacred Lake.

D04: MAJUNGA

Day at leisure for optional activities.





D05 : MAJUNGA -ANJOHIBE CAVES (83km)

The access to the Caves is via 20km of asphalt road followed by a 63km unpaved road. Very varied landscapes, wide savannah dotted with satrana, Sakoa, cashew trees and jujubes. Picnic break by a river, where you can bask in the natural Jacuzzi.

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D06: ANJOHIBE CAVES

The Anjohibe Ecolodge is located in the site. You will visit the Caves which is the most important caving site in Madagascar. Followed by a swim at the natural pool. Campfire.



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DO7 to DO9- ANJOHIBE : CANYONS and WATERFALL

Trek in the Canyon, dotted with small swimming in the different natural pools, to finish at the Mahafanina Waterfall where the lemurs Sifaka watch you closely. Lunch at the camp and in the afternoon, visit a craft market.



D10 -ANJOHIBE - MAJUNGA : CANOE LOCAL

Tour by tradional canoe in Mahajamba Bay. You will pass Sakalava fishing villages, with which you will sail between the mangroves to try to catch the crabs, with their traditional fishing. The region is also known for its rich gambas and oysters. After lunch, return back to Majunga.

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D11- MAJUNGA - ANTANANARIVO (565km):

9h drive back to Antananarivo. Overnight at the hotel.

D12 -ANTANANARIVO - PARIS:

Half-day for buying souvenir at the artisanal market of the Digue. Transfer to the airport. Flight for Paris.
